We as human beings have one great advantage. We have the capacity to *know* and *discover* the greatest truths which impact our lives. We have no idea of our strength and so we suffer. We have no clue of our innate brilliance and so we act in ignorance. We cannot think independently on some of the most important facets of our life. All our thoughts are being influenced either by some book, or a newspaper report or a television or by the thoughts of another person. We have lost our capacity to think independently using the gift of our glorious spirit. And today I want you to think rationally use your intelligence, your divinity and you will be surprised with the results.

Did you know that you can discover in less than ten seconds how the process of creation began in this universe? How the earth, the suns the stars and everything manifested in this universe can be known by you in less than ten seconds and you do not need to be a scientist, or a philosopher or an astronomer to figure that out. You can discover this great secret using plain common sense blended with a touch of wisdom.

Let us do a simple exercise to verify this:

EXERCISE No 1

Close your eyes and imagine that this entire universe is destroyed. There is no sun, moon, stars, human beings, animals, plants and the whole entourage of nature. Nothing exists, absolutely nothing. Now let's recreate this entire universe again.

How do we start?

Here's the secret. We know that the universe no longer exists and is destroyed. **However, it doesn't mean that the "idea of the universe" is destroyed and no longer exists.** The "idea of the universe" still exists and it can't be destroyed; and there is no reason why this "idea of the universe" shouldn't become the cause and reason for the emergence of a new cycle of the universe.

Idea of The Universe

This entire universe could not have come into existence without an idea of the universe. This is the first step in the creation of the universe. What is an idea? It is a subtle intelligence. What is the source of this intelligence? "That one thing" from which everything manifests. Now if we carry this idea further notice that from the idea of the universe emerges the idea of the sun, the idea of the earth, the idea of the air, the idea of water, idea of human beings, the idea of plants, the idea of animals and everything in nature.

The sun couldn't exist without an idea of the sun being in place.

The air couldn't exist without an idea of the air being in place.

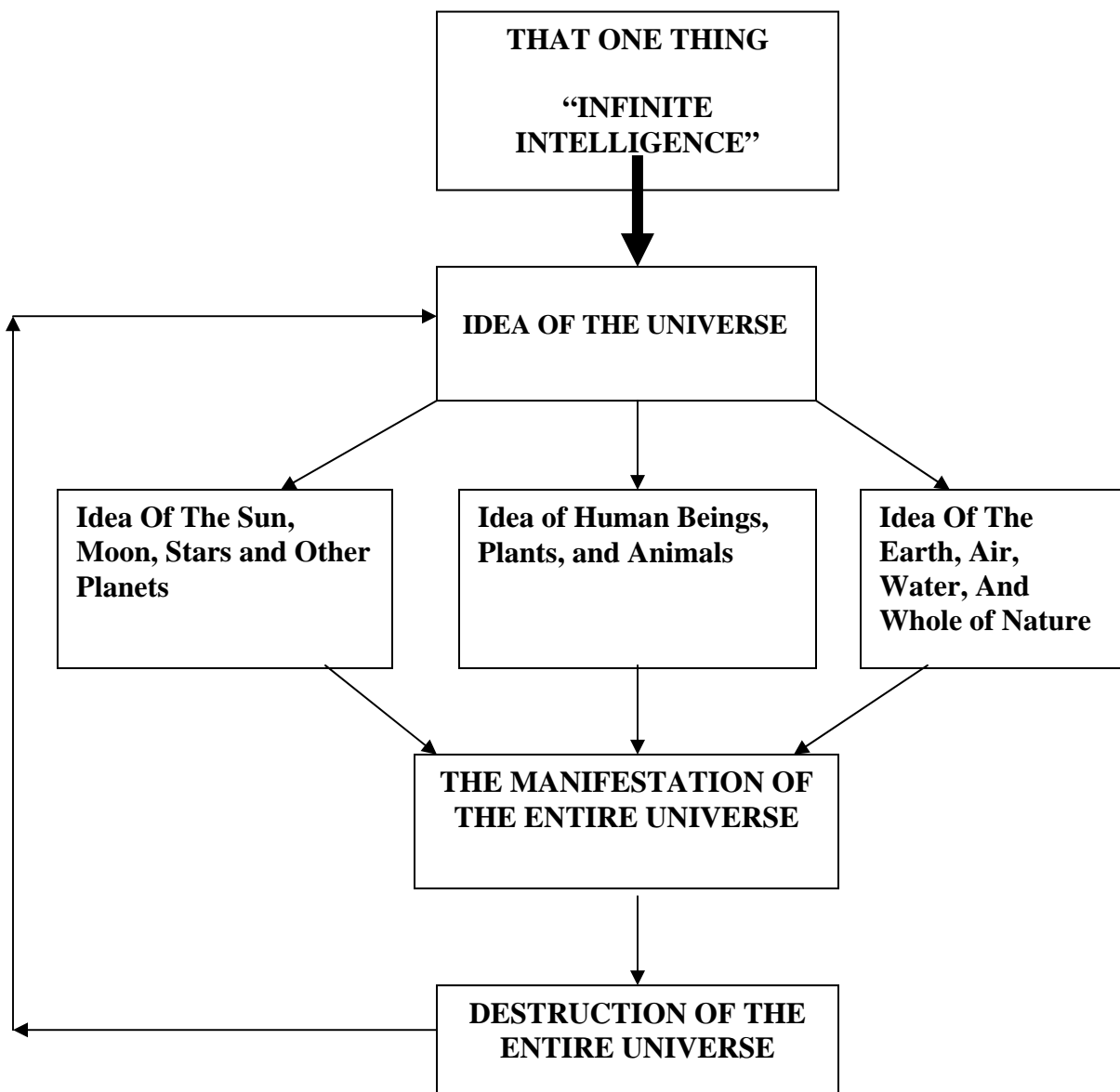
The water couldn't exist without an idea of water being in place.

The animals couldn't exist without an idea of animal being in place.

The human being couldn't exist without an idea of human being in place.

Everything exists in this universe as a result of intelligence and this intelligence is borrowed from the infinite intelligence of "that one thing."

FOOLISH DOUBTS AND THEORIES

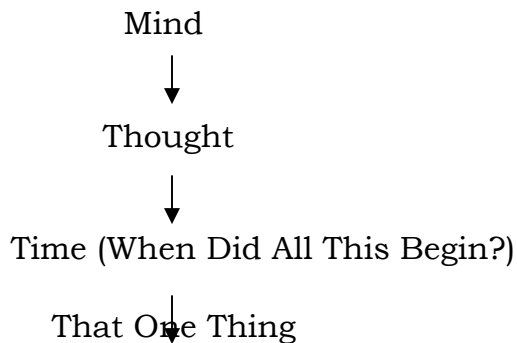
So far we have proceeded very clearly. But since we’re dealing with some of most important questions of life and creation it’s necessary to clarify a few things about the universe before we go further.

When did this “infinite intelligence” begin? When did creation begin? How and when did this universe come into existence? How do we know that “that one thing” always existed?

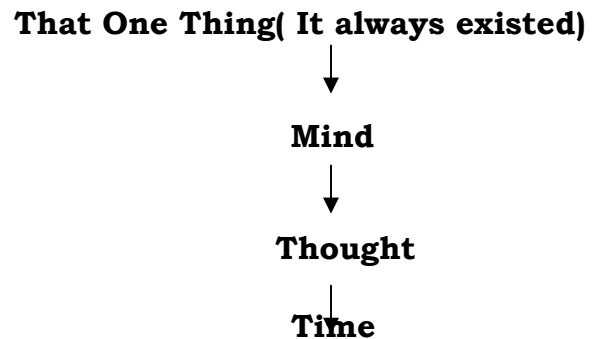
The first thing to understand here is that the word “beginning” is related to time. Time is a thought. “When did all this begin? When did creation begin? Who projected this universe?” These are all thoughts. When the human mind

thinks time manifests itself. If there is no thought there is no time. Time is an outcome of the mind. It exists only in relation to the mind. We saw a little earlier that the intelligence of the mind is borrowed from the infinite intelligence of “that one thing”. So the question “When did all this begin?” doesn’t make any sense because time exists in “that one thing” and not the other way round. Where was time when there was no thought? It was in: that one thing. When “that one thing” reflects its powers on the mind, then the mind thinks that time emerges.

The Right Approach



Notice that in the ignorant way of thinking we start off with the human mind and end with “that one thing” even though we’re aware that the human mind borrows its intelligence from “that one thing.” However, in the right approach, realize that the question “When did all this begin?” does not appear at all because we are completely aware that time is a thought, thought springs from the mind, and the mind is an outcome of the intelligence of “that one thing.” So time always existed in “that one thing.”

How do we know that “that one thing” always existed?

Anything which has a beginning should also have an end. If there is no end there is no beginning. We have seen earlier how “that one thing” has an independent existence. It can’t be acted upon by anything and it can’t be destroyed. Anything

which can't be destroyed can't have an end, and anything which can't have an end can't have a beginning - it should have always existed.

People talk about the beginning of the world, the beginning of human life. **The word beginning simply means the beginning of the cycle.** It nowhere means the beginning of the whole cosmos. It is impossible that creation could have a beginning. That which has a beginning must have an end. **Wherever the beginning of creation is mentioned it means the beginning of the cycle.**

There was a time when there was "neither aught nor naught", when this world did not exist; our mother earth with the seas and oceans, the rivers, and mountains, cities and villages human races, animals, plants, birds, and planets and luminaries, all this infinite variety of creation, had no existence. Are we sure of that? We will try to trace how this conclusion is arrived at. What does man see around him? He takes a little plant. He puts a seed in the ground, and later, he finds a plant peep out, lift itself slowly above the ground, and it grows and grows, till it becomes a gigantic tree. **Then it dies, leaving only the seed. It completes the circle — it comes out of the seed, becomes the tree, and ends in the seed again.**

Look at a bird, how from the egg it springs, lives its life, and then dies, leaving other eggs, seeds of future birds. So with the animals, so with man. Everything in nature begins, as it were, from certain seeds, certain rudiments, certain fine forms, and becomes grosser and grosser, and develops, going on that way for a certain time, and then again goes back to that fine form, and subsides.

The raindrop in which the beautiful sunbeam is playing was drawn in the form of vapour from the ocean, went far away into the air, and reached a region where it changed into water, and dropped down in its present form — to be converted into

vapour again. So with everything in nature by which we are surrounded.

We know that the huge mountains are being worked upon by glaciers and rivers, which are slowly but surely pounding them and pulverising them into sand, that drifts away into the ocean where it settles down on its bed, layer after layer, becoming hard as rocks, once more to be heaped up into mountains of a future generation. Again they will be pounded and pulverized, and thus the course goes on. From sand rise these mountains; unto sand they go and so on....

What does all this mean?

All of creation follows a cycle. The seed becoming the tree and ending in the seed again. The water vapour becoming the rain drop, and ending in form of a vapour again. The sand becoming the mountain and ending in the sand again. An egg becoming a bird and then dying leaving other egg seeds of future birds. How does the tree come into existence? Out of the seed. How does the seed come into existence? Out of the tree which existed before. So it is with the animals, and so with man. **In every cycle there is a beginning and an end. The end is the cause for the new beginning and the beginning is the cause for a new end..**

The effect is nothing but cause in another form.

There is no difference between the seed and the tree. The whole intelligence of the tree must be in the seed. The seed cannot grow into a tree unless the intelligence of the tree is embedded in the seed. You can water a computer all day and keep it in sunshine but no tree will grow out of it. It is all about intelligence.

The cause has to contain the intelligence to produce the required effect.

You might not be able to see the tree in the tiny seed but that doesn't mean that the intelligence of the whole tree can't exist in a subtle form in the seed. So you see the difference between the seed and the tree is only in the manifestation of this intelligence stored within a seed.

If it's true that nature is uniform throughout, that the same method under which the seed is created, works in creating the gigantic suns and stars and all of this universe, if it is true that the whole universe is built on exactly the same plan as the atom, if it be true that the same law prevails throughout the universe, then if we know the tiny seed we understand the secret of the whole universe.

THE SECRET OF THE UNIVERSE

Evolution is impossible without involution.

We know that a tree can't come into existence without the seed. We also know that the entire intelligence of the tree must exist or be involved in that small seed or else it can't grow into a gigantic tree. Evolution is the final effect in the form of a giant tree and involution is the primal cause in the form of intelligence present in the tiny seed. The beginning and the end must always be the same. It just can't be otherwise. The difference is only in the manifestation of the intelligence stored in the seed. This brings us to a very important discovery in human evolution:

If we can find the end we can also find the beginning.

What is the end, and the ultimate effect of evolution?

The end is the most evolved being in the universe. Who is the most evolved being in the universe? One who has the most evolved notion of the universe. What is the most evolved notion that human beings have of the universe? It is intelligence, a very fine expression of "that one thing." Take the example of

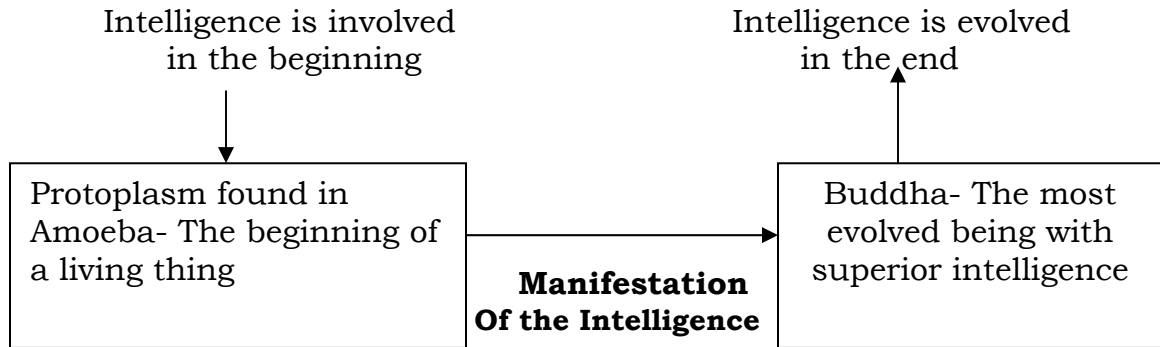
Buddha, considered one of the most evolved beings who has ever lived with his perfect unselfishness, infinite sacrifice, and love for every being in the universe. If we consider him the end of evolution it follows then that the infinite intelligence of Buddha also existed in the beginning because the beginning and the end is always the same. If in the end we find the perfect man so in the beginning it must have been the same. How do we know that?

If the law of conservation of energy is true than you cannot get an amount of work out of a machine unless you have put it in some form or shape at the other end. If you want a mass of energy at one end, you have got to put it in at the other end, it maybe in another form but the amount of energy that should be produced out of it should be the same. **There cannot be added in the economy of this universe one particle of matter or one foot-pound of force, nor can one particle of matter or one foot-pound of force be taken out.** If that is the case and if a Buddha is the one end of the change where did that intelligence come from? If it was not present in the protoplasm it must have come all of a sudden, something coming out of nothing which is absurd..

See that the intelligence of a Buddha, Krishna, Christ, Moses, Mohammad and other evolved beings should have been involved in the cell of protoplasm which is the other end of the same chain. Now If you apply the same reason to the whole of the universe notice that intelligence is the both the primal cause and the ultimate effect of creation. At the beginning that intelligence becomes involved and in the end that intelligence becomes evolved. The sum total of the intelligence which is present in this universe is nothing but a manifestation of that involved intelligence present in “that one thing.”

So what does all this mean to you?

Every single thing existing in the universe carries the infinite intelligence of “that one thing.” From the lowest worm crawling under your feet to the noblest and the greatest saints, all of us have this infinite power and purity.
